National Identification and Verification Act 2025:11

An act for the purpose of establishing Mabruenian Identification System.



PREAMBLE

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Grand Assembly of the Gaelic Kingdom of Mabruenia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Article I – Definitions

For the purpose of this act–

1. “Kingdom” refers to the Gaelic Kingdom of Mabruenia
 2. “Assembly” refers to the Grand Assembly of Mabruenia
 3. Any other definitions specific to the act

Article II – Provisions

Section !:

1. The Mabruenian Identification System (MIS) is hereby established as the official means of verifying identity and citizenship within the Kingdom.

2. The issuance, design, and regulation of ID cards shall fall under the authority of the **Ministry of Citizenship**, in coordination with the **Ministry of Justice**.
3. The Royal Treasury shall provide the necessary funds for the production and management of identification cards.

Section II

1. **Royal Identification Cards** shall be issued to members of the Royal Family, distinguished by a gold background.
2. **Noble Identification Cards** shall be issued to peers of the realm, including Dukes, Marquesses, Counts, Viscounts, and Barons, bearing a silver background..
3. **Government Identification Cards** shall be issued to officials of the executive, legislative, and judicial branches, with a green background.
4. **Citizen Identification Cards** shall be issued to natural-born and naturalized citizens of Mabruenia, with a crimson background.
5. **Honorary Identification Cards** may be issued by Royal Decree to recognized honorary citizens and diplomats.

Section III:

1. Identification cards shall serve as proof of citizenship, residence, and lawful status in the Kingdom.
2. ID cards may be used for elections, military enlistment, official appointments, and verification of rights or titles.
3. Counterfeiting or misuse of identification shall be considered a serious offense under the **Royal Penal Code**.

Section IV:

1. All citizens must register for identification within **30 days** of citizenship confirmation or upon reaching the age of **16**.

2. ID cards shall remain valid for a period of **5 years**, after which they must be renewed.
3. Lost or damaged cards must be reported immediately to the **Office of Identification** within the Ministry of Citizenship.

Section V:

1. All identification cards shall display the **Royal Arms of Mabruenia**, the individual's **name, citizenship category, and serial number, and birth date..**
2. The background color shall correspond to the category of citizenship.
3. Designs shall be approved by the **Crown** and recorded within the **Registry of State Symbols.**

Enforcement

1. This act shall be enforced by the Ministry of Justice and Ministry of Citizenship.
2. Any violations of this act shall be subject to penalties determined by the Ministry of Justice.

Article IV — Implementation

1. This Act shall come into force upon receiving **Royal Assent** from Her Majesty the Queen.
