The "Right of Soil" (Native-Born) Clause:

"Digital Citizenship status shall be categorized as Native Born for any individual born within the territorial boundaries of the Kingdom, including the claimed lands of the New Mexico territories. This status is a birthright, is irrevocable, and grants full eligibility for all high offices of the state, including the Chancellorship and the Judiciary."

The "Code of Digital Conduct" Clause:

"Digital Citizenship status is contingent upon adherence to the Kingdom's values of peace and anti-extremism. Support for, or affiliation with, recognized fascist, Nazi, or extremist entities—including but not limited to the Third Reich, Imperial Germany, designated terrorist organizations, or Micronations heavily based on them—shall constitute a breach of the Oath of Allegiance and result in the immediate revocation of Digital Citizenship and all associated rights."

The "Equality of Presence" Clause:

"The Kingdom of Mabruenia recognizes that as a global project, physical and digital residency are legally equivalent. Digital citizens shall enjoy the same protections under the Equality and Discrimination Act 2025 as physical residents, provided their digital conduct remains within the bounds of Royal Federal Law."

The "Platform vs. Nation" Distinction:

"While digital platforms (such as the community server) serve as an administrative hub for the Realm, the Laws of Mabruenia apply to the individual citizen regardless of the platform used."

Violations of national law in digital spaces shall be subject to the same penalties as physical crimes, including exile (server banning) and fines."

The "Automatic Revocation" Clause:

"The Crown reserves the right to summarily suspend digital credentials (RDIN) and server access for any individual found to be promoting extremist ideologies or violating the safety of the digital community. Such actions are considered 'Protective Administrative Sanctions' and are effective immediately."
