

# *Mabruenian Flag Code 2025*

*Issued by the Monarch of the Mabreunian Kingdom*

*Enacted 11/18/2025*

---

## **1. PURPOSE**

The Mabruenian Flag Code establishes proper rules for displaying, storing, and respecting the national flag of the Mabruenian Kingdom, its provinces, and royal standard.

This code is binding to all government institutions and advisory for civilians.

## **2. THE NATIONAL FLAG**



Proportion: 3:5 (36 inches by 60 inches)

Meaning of colors: Blue: the sky. Red: The blood spilled by our ancestors. White: Purity.

Date of Adoption: September 28th, 2024.

## 3. *GENERAL RULES OF DISPLAY*

### 3.1 Order of Precedence

1. Royal Standard of the Monarch
2. National Flag of Mabruenia
3. Provincial Flags
4. Military Branch Flags
5. Foreign Flags
6. Organizational Flags

### 3.2 Times When Flags Must Be Displayed

- Government buildings (Daily)
- Schools (daily)
- National holidays

- Royal anniversaries
- Emergency announcements

### 3.3 Illumination

If flown at night, the flag **must be illuminated**.

## 4. HOISTING AND LOWERING

- The flag must be raised briskly.
  - It must be lowered ceremonially and slowly.
  - No flag may be flown higher than the Royal Standard when it is present.

## 5. HALF-MAST PROTOCOL

The flag shall be flown at half-mast during:

- National mourning declared by the Queen.
- Death of a Monarch.
- Death of major national figures.
- Remembrance holidays.

Procedure:

- Raise fully
  - Lower to half-mast
  - Reverse at sunset.
- 

## 6. PROHIBITED USES

The national flag may **not** be:

- Used as clothing
- Used as drapery

- Placed on the ground
- Used for advertising
- Altered or defaced
- Used in protests that destroy or burn it.

Punishments for breaking these prohibitions can range from fines to expulsion from the nation.

---

## *7. RETIREMENT OF DAMAGED FLAGS*

When a flag becomes worn, it must be respectfully burned in a private ceremony.
