

Mabruenian Marriage, death, and births act.

July 23rd, 2025

Section one: Purpose.

If at any given time within the Mabruenian kingdom, that someone wishes to marry, a death occurs, or a birth occurs, laws must be put into place to prevent heinous actions which could harm others.

Section two: Qualifications for Marriage.

- Both parties must be over, or of the age of 18 years old.
- Both parties must be consenting to the marriage, if one or both denies the marriage, it shall not take place under any circumstance.
- Marriages to close relatives (Siblings, Parents, all cousins whether direct or removed must be at least 3 generations apart, Children, Grandparents, Great Grandparents, 2x Great Grandparents), whether by blood or adopted, must not take place under any circumstance.
- Both Parties must be living, if one or both parties are deceased a marriage can not take place.
- Only two people can be married to each other in Mabruenia, three or more people at this time can not be married to each other, additionally a person can only have one spouse.

Section three: Deaths

- In order for a death to be recorded, proper papers from the local authorities from the citizen must be provided.
- If a death is falsified or fabricated, authorities of the citizen of origin will be notified.

- Death records will only go to the family of the citizen, and will not be released to the public.
- Deaths will be recorded with the Chancellery of Names and Ways.

Religious exemptions

- Any religion that has different views for point 5 in qualifications are exempt.

Section four: Births

- For a birth to be recorded, proper papers, IE; birth certificate must be provided.
- If an individual is born in Mabruenia, they automatically gain citizenship, courtesy of Amendment 8.
- Births will be recorded with the Chancellery of Names and Ways.

Section five: Immigration

Eligibility for Immigration

- Submit a valid application to the Monarch, Prime Minister, or Chancellery of Names and Ways.
- Undergo background checks and provide verifiable identification.
- Demonstrate purpose of immigration

- Residency shall be classified into the following categories:
 -
 - **Permanent Residency:** Eligible for citizens of allied nations, approved immigrants, and family of Mabruenian citizens.
 - **Temporary Residency:** Granted for study, employment, or humanitarian purposes.
 - **Diplomatic Residency:** Granted to representatives of recognized foreign entities.

Rights of Residents

Legal residents are entitled to:

- Legal protection under Mabruenian law.
- Access to public services (as designated).

- Right to apply for citizenship after a determined period.

EXEMPTIONS

1. **Diplomatic Exemption**

Persons holding diplomatic credentials recognized by the Kingdom are exempt from standard immigration processing.

2. **Emergency Humanitarian Cases**

Applicants facing verified humanitarian crises (e.g., war refugees, stateless individuals) may receive expedited or exempted processing under the Emergency Migration Protocol (EMP-01).

3. **Minors & Dependents**

Children under 16 and legally dependent individuals immigrating with a legal guardian or parent may be processed under simplified procedures.

4. **Duties of Residents**

Residents must:

- Abide by all Mabruenian laws and customs.
- Report change of address or status within 30 days.
- Renew temporary permits before expiration.
