Subject: Judicial Report on the Matter of *Crown vs. Andrew* (2026)

Date: April 5, 2026

I. Case Overview

The matter of *Crown vs. Andrew* was initiated following a series of disruptive actions and communications intended to undermine the Sovereign's Zero-Tolerance policy on extremism. The Court sought to determine if the subject's persistent pushback against the Digital Citizenship and Rights Act constituted a breach of peace and a defiance of Royal and Ministerial authority.

II. Findings of the Court

Upon review of the digital transcripts and the subject's interactions with the Minister of Justice (Selus), the Court finds the following:

- **Obstruction of Legal Mandates:** The subject engaged in persistent, circular arguments intended to delegitimize the Crown's right to define "prohibited support." This conduct served to obstruct the clear implementation of national safety protocols.
- **Contempt of Ministerial Authority:** The subject repeatedly dismissed the directives of the Minister of Justice, opting to frame legal compliance as a negotiable philosophical debate rather than a requirement of citizenship.
- **Incitement of Dissent:** By publicly challenging the "Zero-Tolerance" mandate during a state of heightened security, the subject's rhetoric threatened the stability of the digital realm and the safety of its citizens.

III. Final Verdict and Administrative Conclusion

The Court finds that Andrew has demonstrated a fundamental lack of allegiance to the Kingdom of Mabruenia. Citizenship is a privilege contingent upon the respect of the Realm's laws and the Sovereign's decrees. The subject's refusal to acknowledge the validity of the Kingdom's anti-extremism laws renders him a liability to the national order.

Consequently, this case is concluded with a verdict of **Digital Exile**. The subject's Digital Citizenship status is hereby **Revoked**, and he is permanently excluded from all official platforms of the Kingdom.

IV. Judicial Certification

As Chief Justice and Provost, I certify that this ruling is necessary to preserve the judicial integrity and the collective security of the Gaelic Kingdom. The subject's actions prove an irreconcilable conflict with the "Good Standing" required by this Office.
