



Royal Federal Act 2025:18

Provincial Governance Reorganization Act of Mabruenia

Introduced by: The Monarch

Category: Executive

Preamble

An Act establishing the structure, authority, and administration of the Provinces of Val Regina, Oria Montes, and Civis Streda; defining the offices of Provincial Government; and clarifying relations with the Royal Government.

Section I – Establishment of Provincial Governments

1. The Kingdom of Mabruenia shall be divided into **three Provinces**:
 - **Val Regina Province**
 - **Oria Montes Province**
 - **Civis Streda Province**
 2. Each Province shall possess its own civil government under the sovereignty of the Crown and subject to the Constitution.
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Section II – Provincial Executive Authority

1. Each Province shall be headed by a **Governor**, elected by the citizens of the Province for a term of **4 years**.
2. The Governor shall:
 - a. Enforce provincial laws
 - b. Oversee provincial agencies
 - c. Act as the chief administrator
 - d. Coordinate emergency response with the national government
3. Each Province shall maintain a **Provincial Cabinet**, consisting of:
 - Provincial Secretary of Finance
 - Provincial Secretary of Agriculture
 - Provincial Secretary of Justice
 - Provincial Secretary of Public Works

- Additional offices created by provincial law
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Section III – The Royal Provincial Steward

1. The Monarch shall appoint a **Royal Steward** to each Province.
 2. The Steward shall not interfere with elected governance.
 3. The Steward shall:
 - a. Represent the Crown
 - b. Conduct ceremonial duties
 - c. Oversee adherence to constitutional norms
 - d. Deliver the Royal Address to the Province annually
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Section IV – Provincial Assemblies

1. Each Province shall have a **Provincial Assembly**, consisting of elected members.
 2. Assemblies may:
 - a. Pass provincial laws
 - b. Approve provincial budgets
 - c. Establish municipal districts
 - d. Oversee provincial agencies
 3. All acts of a Provincial Assembly shall require the Governor's signature.
 4. A veto may be overridden by a $\frac{2}{3}$ **majority** of the Assembly.
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Section V – Relation to the Royal Government

1. Provincial laws may not contradict Royal or National law.
2. In times of national emergency, the Crown may empower:

- The Lord High Chancellor
 - The Minister of Provincial Affairs
 - The Minister of Homeland Security
to assume temporary control of provincial emergency management.
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Section VI – Judicial Oversight

1. Each Province shall maintain **Provincial Courts**.
 2. Appeals from Provincial Courts shall be heard by the **Supreme Court of Mabruenia**.
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Section VII – Enactment

This Act shall enter into force upon the signature of the Monarch and approval of the Grand Assembly.
