



Royal Federal Act No. 15, Year 2025

The Treaty Ratification and Diplomatic Missions Act

Introduced by: The Monarch

Category: Executive

Preamble

To preserve the sovereignty, integrity, and lawful representation of the Gaelic Kingdom of Mabruenia abroad, this Act defines the authority, process, and regulation of treaties and diplomatic missions, ensuring all international engagements reflect the will of the Crown and the consent of Parliament.

Section I – Authority of the Crown and Government

1. The power to negotiate treaties, conventions, or international agreements lies with the **Crown**, acting through the **Ministry of Foreign Relations**.
 2. No treaty or foreign pact shall take effect without formal **ratification by the Grand Assembly**, unless declared an emergency treaty by Royal Decree.
 3. The Monarch retains the right to withdraw from or suspend treaties in times of crisis or national threat, upon consultation with the Chancellor.

Section II – Ratification Process

1. All proposed treaties shall be submitted to the **Committee of Foreign Affairs** within the Grand Assembly.
 2. The Committee shall examine the treaty's compliance with Mabruenian law and national interest.
 3. Upon approval by a two-thirds majority vote of the Grand Assembly, the treaty shall be ratified under the **Royal Seal of Mabruenia**.
 4. The ratified treaty shall be published in the *Royal Gazette* and entered into the *Treaty Register of Mabruenia*.

Section III – Diplomatic Missions

1. The **Ministry of Foreign Relations** shall maintain diplomatic missions, consulates, and embassies as authorized by the Crown.

2. Ambassadors and Consuls shall be appointed by the Monarch upon the recommendation of the Minister of Foreign Relations.
 3. Each mission shall serve as a representation of the Kingdom's dignity, responsible for political, cultural, and humanitarian affairs abroad.
 4. Diplomatic envoys shall enjoy full protection and immunity under international law and Mabruenian statute.

Section IV – Emergency and Special Agreements

1. In matters of urgent security or humanitarian crisis, the Crown may enact temporary agreements under **Royal Emergency Decree**, lasting no more than **90 days** without legislative approval.
 2. Such emergency treaties shall be subject to parliamentary review upon conclusion of the crisis.

Section V – Oversight and Records

1. The *Treaty Register of Mabruenia* shall be managed by the Ministry of Foreign Relations and maintained in the **Royal Archives**.
 2. The Register shall include:
 - a. The treaty title and partner nation
 - b. The date of signing and ratification
 - c. Responsible representatives and diplomatic agents
 - d. Summary of contents and obligations

Section VI – Enactment

This Act shall come into force immediately upon royal assent, and all prior conflicting statutes or decrees concerning foreign relations shall stay in place..
