

Royal Federal Act No. 2025:09

The Anri-Zionism and Condemnation of Israeli genocide Act

Preamble

In recognition of the right of the Palestinian people to self-determination, and in accordance to U.N. laws of war, in rejection of Zionist oppression, The Royal Dominion of Mabruenia enacts the following provisions.

Section I: Definitions

1. *Zionism* shall be defined as the political movement advocating for the state of Israel over the Palestinian people.
 2. *Defense of Israeli actions in Gaza* shall mean any public statement, publication, or action that justifies, condones, or promotes military or political acts of Israel in the Gaza Strip.
 3. *BDS Movement* refers to the category of boycott, divestment, or sanctions directed at Israel and its institutions

Section II: Prohibitions

1. Any citizen of Mabruenia who defends Israeli actions in Gaza commits a Felony.
 2. All Mabruenian companies are required to comply with the Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) movement and shall not engage in trade, contracts, or financial cooperation with Israeli companies or citizens.
 3. Citizens of Mabruenia are forbidden from travelling to Israel for Tourism purposes.
 - Travel to Israel shall only be authorized for the purpose of protest or official acts of solidarity, as approved by the Grand Assembly or Royal Authority.
 4. The formation or operation of Zionist political parties within Mabruenia is prohibited

Section III: Penalties

1. Violation of Section II, Article 1 shall be punishable by exile not less than 5 years, or a fine of \$100.
 2. Violation of Section II, Article 2 shall result in corporate dissolution, fines, or revocation of trading licences.
 3. Violation of Section II, Article 3 shall result in confiscation of passport and exile up to 5 years.
 4. Violation of Section II, Article 4 shall result in immediate disbandment of the political organization and criminal charges against its leadership.

Section IV: Enforcement

1. The Royal Police Service and the Ministry of Justice shall be responsible for investigating and prosecuting anyone under this Act.
2. The Grand Assembly shall maintain oversight of enforcement to ensure compliance with Mabruenia's constitutional principles.
